# SCOTT McLAUGHLIN

Scott McLaughlin continued his evolution from a championship-winning touring car driver to an NTT INDYCAR SERIES superstar in 2024, finishing as the highest-ranked Team Penske driver in the final series standings for the second consecutive season. After producing three wins – including his first on an oval track at Iowa Speedway in July – and a record-setting pole position run for the 108th Indianapolis 500, McLaughlin enters the 2025 season as one of the favorites to claim his first series championship. With an outstanding partner lineup on the No. 3 Chevrolet that includes XPEL, DEX Imaging, Gallagher, Pennzoil, Sonsio, Good Ranchers, Odyssey Battery and Freightliner, McLaughlin is poised to build on his success in 2025.

One of the most successful racers in the history of Australian Supercars, McLaughlin jumped at the chance to move to the United States and compete full-time for Team Penske in the NTT INDYCAR SERIES in 2021. Racing the No. 3 Chevrolet, McLaughlin captured the INDYCAR SERIES Rookie of the Year Award, as he became the first Team Penske driver to win the honor since its inception in 1979. In his four INDYCAR seasons competing for Team Penske, McLaughlin has scored seven wins, and his nine NTT P1 Pole Awards has extended his reign as the best qualifier in team history with 69 career pole positions, including his Supercars career totals.

McLaughlin resides in Charlotte, N.C. with his wife Karly and their new daughter Lucy. A proud sports fan, McLaughlin has adopted the Carolina Panthers as his favorite NFL team, and he also follows the University of Wisconsin Badgers college football team. McLaughlin continues to root for New Zealand's All Blacks rugby team, and he is an avid golfer.
